



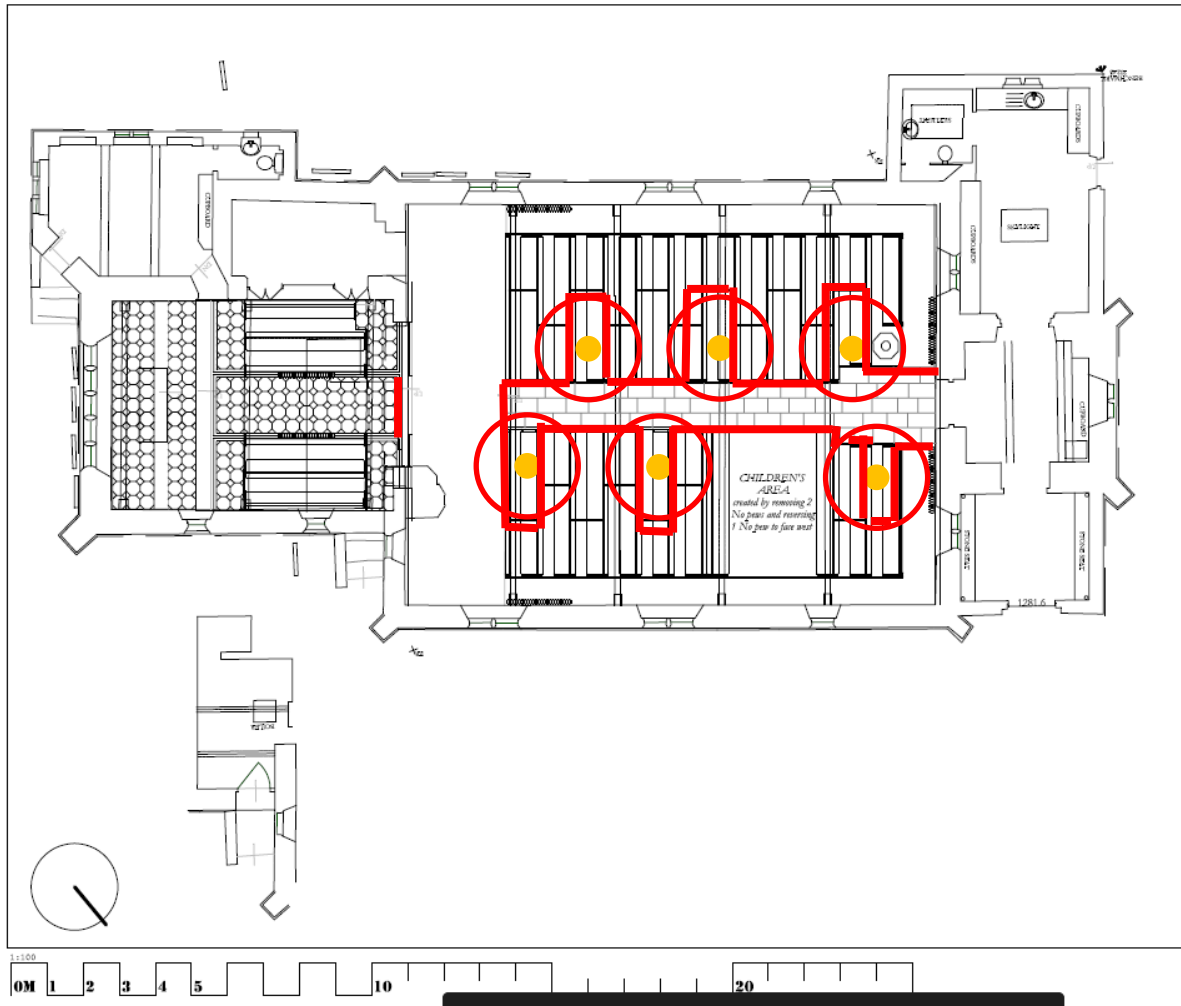
Private Prayer and Reflection Risk Assessment

| Order of Service | Risk Identified | Mitigating Actions |

| Prior to entering the church building - Outside Church | Social Distancing to be maintained. | No congregating outside the church in the church yard |
| Entering the church - Inside Church | Social Distancing to be maintained; Public Health Guidelines to be maintained. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - There can be a maximum of 6 people in church at any one time. - Stewards will assist on the day. - They will ensure no more than 6 people are present at any time. - They will obtain 'Track and Trace' details for the register, ensure that people sanitise their hands as they enter church, and that face masks are worn at all times. - Stewards will indicate which pews are available for use. |
| During PP&R - Inside Church | COVID 19 Security maintained | PP&R will be in silence |
| Withdrawal from church | Social Distancing to be maintained. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - On leaving the pew, the 'pew unavailable' card will be displayed - The visitor will use sanitiser gel as they leave - The steward will make that pew unavailable for further use |
| Post PP&R - Outside Church | Social Distancing to be maintained. | No congregating outside the church in the church yard |
| Toilets | Access to toilets | No access to the toilets |
| Disabled access | Visitors needing wheelchair | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The church building is accessible for wheelchairs, there is space near the font and in the children's area. - Visitor associated with wheelchair user will sit in the adjacent pew. |

Once all the PPR spaces in the pews have been used (six) no more people will be admitted.

- Red circles are 1m radius from the people
- Maximum of 6 people
- To maintain a social distance of 2m
